1	<p>Welcome & Apologies Apologies were received from Councillor Inoki.</p>	
2	<p>Pop Up Events The Chair outlined the agreement reached with Rob Harriman in respect of the provision of 'pop up' events across the parish.</p> <p>She reported having met with him 4 times in recent weeks and that 3 events had been targeted. The first of these was to be a roof-top party in the Hub. However, even though over 300 leaflets had been circulated there were only three responses offering support for the event, and this has now been cancelled.</p> <p>A similar lack of response was found in the development of the second event, which was to be an international Games event in the City gardens.</p> <p>Due to the lack of success of these events, the Chair proposed that an alternative strategy be developed. The proposal was made that the focus for Rob's efforts should be turned onto outreach within existing residents' networks in collaboration with the local Police officer, such as residents' associations etc, which enable the Town Council to understand the issues from these groups and seek to address or champion these. Additionally, the model could be used to enable residents to develop their own association, where this currently does not exist.</p> <p>After some discussion, the proposal was agreed.</p> <p>It was agreed that a launch event be planned for the play area, if this was agreed by Development Control.</p>	
3	<p>Planning Applications for the centre:mk and relocation of the market. At this juncture the meeting became 'in camera' and minutes were not recorded.</p>
