

# **PUBLIC NOTICE**

## **THE COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF MILTON KEYNES (VARIOUS ROADS, CAMPBELL PARK) (PROHIBITION OF WAITING) ORDER 2018**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Council of the Borough of Milton Keynes proposes to make the above Traffic Regulation Order under Sections 1(1), 2(1) and (2) and 4 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The proposed Order will introduce 'No Waiting at Any Time' restrictions along parts of Adelphi Street in Campbell Park (at its junction with Silbury Boulevard).

The reason for the above proposal is concerns over road safety and obstruction due to inconsiderate parking.

The proposed waiting restrictions will help alleviate obstruction and allow the free passage for emergency vehicles and encourage a safer environment for motorists, pedestrians and cyclists throughout the road.

Milton Keynes Council is now carrying out statutory consultation on the proposed amendments.

Any objections to the proposal, together with the grounds on which they are made, must be **made in writing** and sent to the Network TRO Manager, Highways Department, Public Realm Services Group, Synergy Park, Chesney Wold, Bleak Hall, Milton Keynes, MK6 1LY **to be received** no later than 17<sup>th</sup> May 2018 quoting reference **PH-S1-TRO-222**.

A copy of the proposed Order together with a map showing the areas referred to along with a statement of reason for proposing the Order, may be inspected during opening hours at Milton Keynes Library, 555 Silbury Boulevard, Central Milton Keynes, and during normal office hours at Milton Keynes Council, Civic Offices, 1 Saxon Gate East, Milton Keynes.
