P99/18	<p>18/02391/REM, including 18/02269/DISCON Moxy Hotel The paper, as previously circulated, was noted.</p> <p>Condition 7- Generally, the materials were considered acceptable, but some reassurance sought in respect of the durability of the cladding. Condition 11- Acceptable proposals Condition 12- Acceptable proposals</p> <p>Condition 13- It was agreed that there need to be firm assurances that the exit route for delivery vehicles will remain open in perpetuity. Closure of the exit route would result in delivery vehicles using the boulevard to unload, causing congestion.</p> <p>Pedestrian right of way- An additional issue was brought forward, reflecting concerns expressed by a resident to Councillor Kurth. After discussion it was agreed that this issue needs to be raised in the response to the Reserved Matters application. The Planning Advisor has agreed to look into the issue further, clarifying the Conditions as approved within the Outline Permission. Further to clarification on this matter, the Vice Chair agreed to work with the Planning Advisor to draft an objection incorporating Condition 13 and raising the issue of ensuring pedestrian safety, albeit any solution appears to lie outside the boundary of the current application.</p>	<p>JM/LI</p>
