19/186	Representations from the Public No members of the public were present.	
19/187	Finance Paper The paper, as previously circulated, was noted. The new standing order in respect of the monthly office hire was confirmed and duly signed.	
19/188	Forward Plan Monitoring Sheet The paper, as previously circulated, was noted.	

	Councillor Thomas gave an update in respect of the MK:University project, noting that funding had not yet been fully realised, but progress was being made and that all parties are getting behind the project with the aim of ensuring a positive outcome.	
19/189	Amended Disciplinary and Grievance Procedures The papers, as previously circulated, were noted.	
	It was agreed that both the Grievance and Disciplinary policies be adopted in substitution for those currently forming part of the Town Council's policies and procedures.	
19/190	Campbell Park Needle Finds The papers, as previously circulated, were noted.	
	Whilst noting, with concern, the number of needles found by Park Rangers in the vicinity of the underpasses adjacent to 'Chain Reaction', the Town Council did not feel that the solution would be to close the underpasses, even if this were achievable.	
	Councillor Thomas noted that the underpasses are part of the public highway and cannot be closed for such a purpose. Additionally, with work beginning on the Campbell Park Northside development in the near future, the removal of pedestrian transit routes would not be advisable.	
	It was agreed that an offer be made to meet with the Parks Trust and MKDP to discuss options to manage the current situation in the most effective manner. Clerk to respond accordingly.	PC
19/191	Campbell Park Dog Waste Bins The paper, as previously circulated, was noted.	
	Councillors expressed their satisfaction with the outcome, whilst noting that there is still a risk that the contractor may withdraw from provision of the service should matters not significantly improve when the rubbish bin is installed.	
	The Clerk to check when the rubbish bin is in situ and chase if there are delays in this regard.	PC
