The Chair noted that the substantive objection submission, as included in the papers, had been lodged in accordance with the agreed position at the February Planning Committee meeting. He also noted that, subsequent to agreement to lodge an objection, an additional area of concern had been identified and that the detail of this was outlined for consideration of this meeting.

The proximity of the proposed development to the listed Campbell Park was felt to be of concern and would adversely impact upon enjoyment of the park's vista.

Concerns were expressed at the relative height of the development in comparison with the current skyline when viewed from the park and that insufficient weight was afforded to the issue of the impact of the development on Campbell Park.

It was noted that a much lower-level development, closer to the canal but also adjacent to the park, was subject to an objection by the Conservation Officer.

After some consideration it was unanimously agreed that a further objection be submitted expressing these concerns.
