In the next ten years, CMK will see a massive increase in the number of residents, students, workers and visitors.

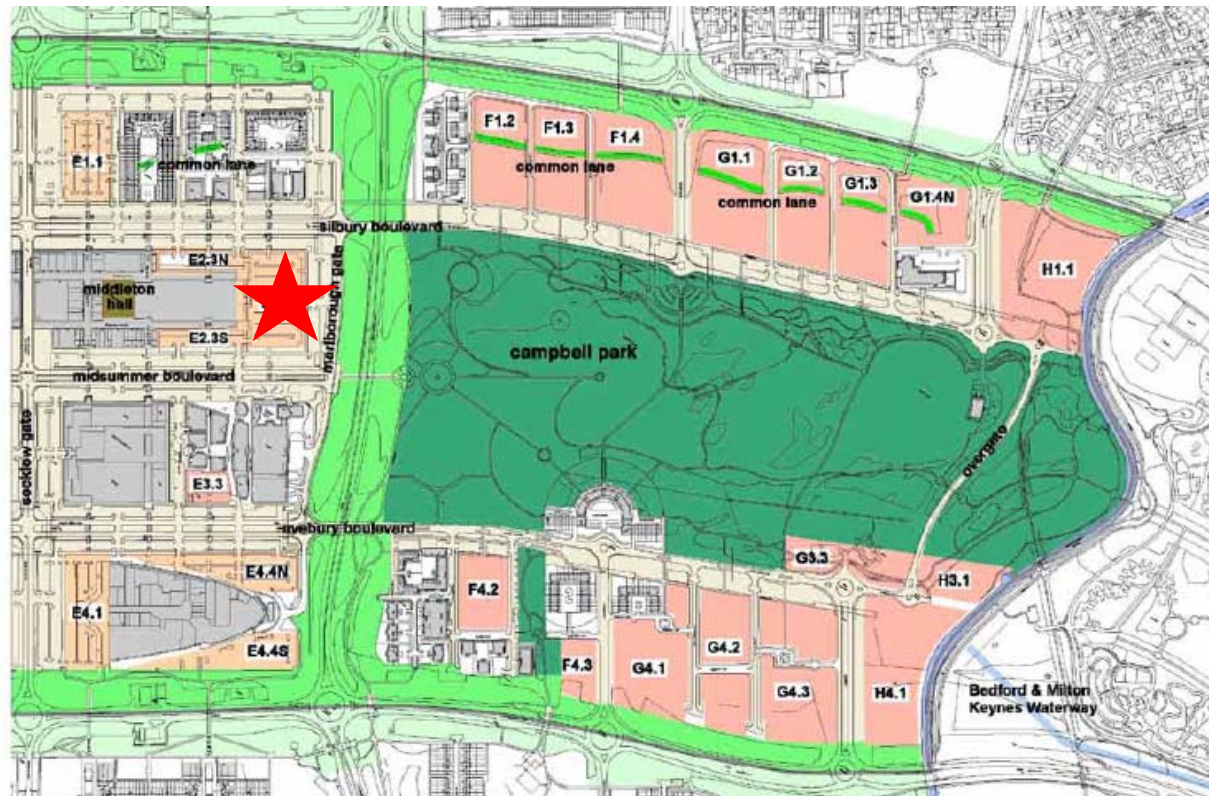

A SITE OF STRATEGIC IMPORTANCE



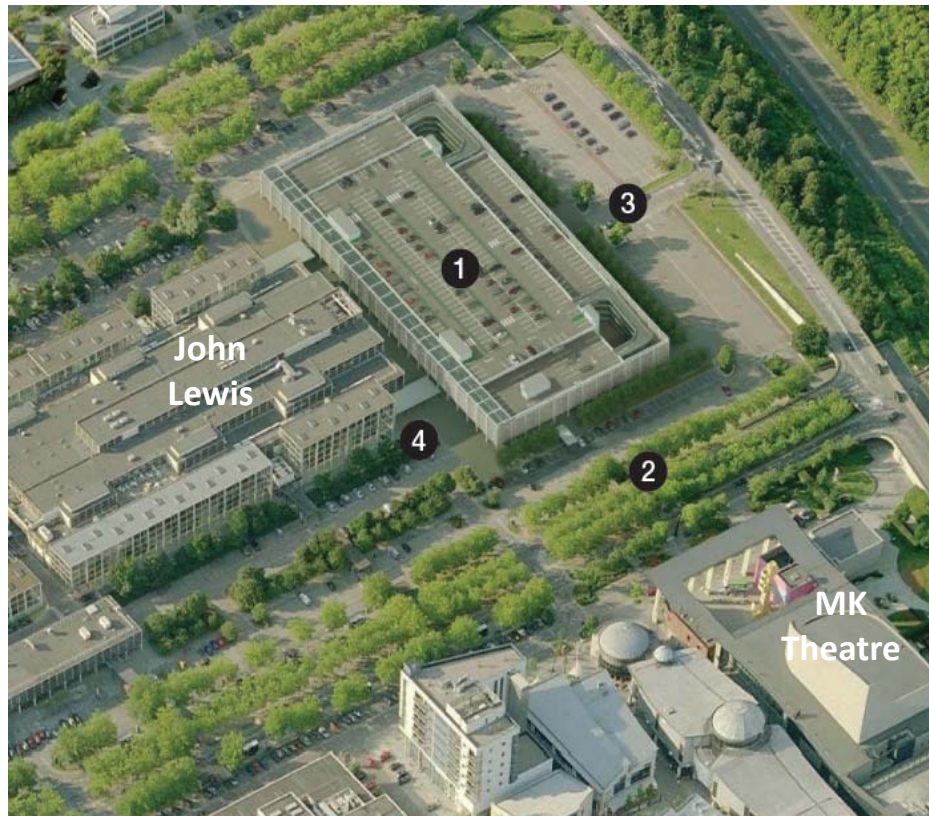
*Most of this growth will be within a short walk of the development site.

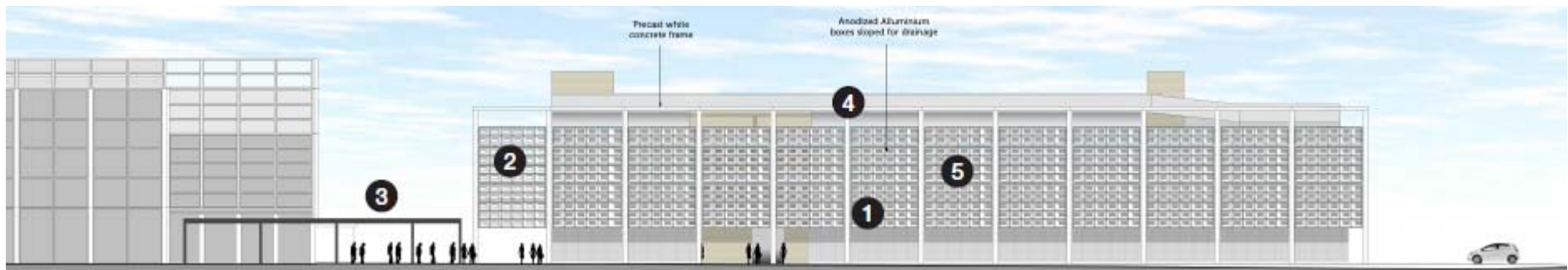
- ❶ *MSCP is too big – covers the entire site with parking and nothing else;*
- ❷ *MSCP will not enliven Midsummer Blvd or enhance Theatre and Gallery;*
- ❸ *Poor access off single-carriageway will disrupt traffic flows and many bus routes;*
- ❹ *Acts as barrier to pedestrians and views over Campbell Park.*

PROBLEMS WITH CURRENT PROPOSAL

Other drawbacks include the car park's monolithic, concrete design and long stretches of blank walls next to pedestrian pavement.

A BETTER WAY: NEW HORIZONS PROPOSAL

Concept = deliver a “mixed-use” multi-storey car park

- Deliver c.1,000 parking spaces in MSCP element
- Different access arrangements to keep traffic flowing on local roads
- Open up future development opportunities
- Provide new amenities and enliven Midsummer & Silbury Blvds
- Create well-lit, safe 24-hour north-south pedestrian route
- Enhance the Listed building and links to Campbell Park
- Enable phased development

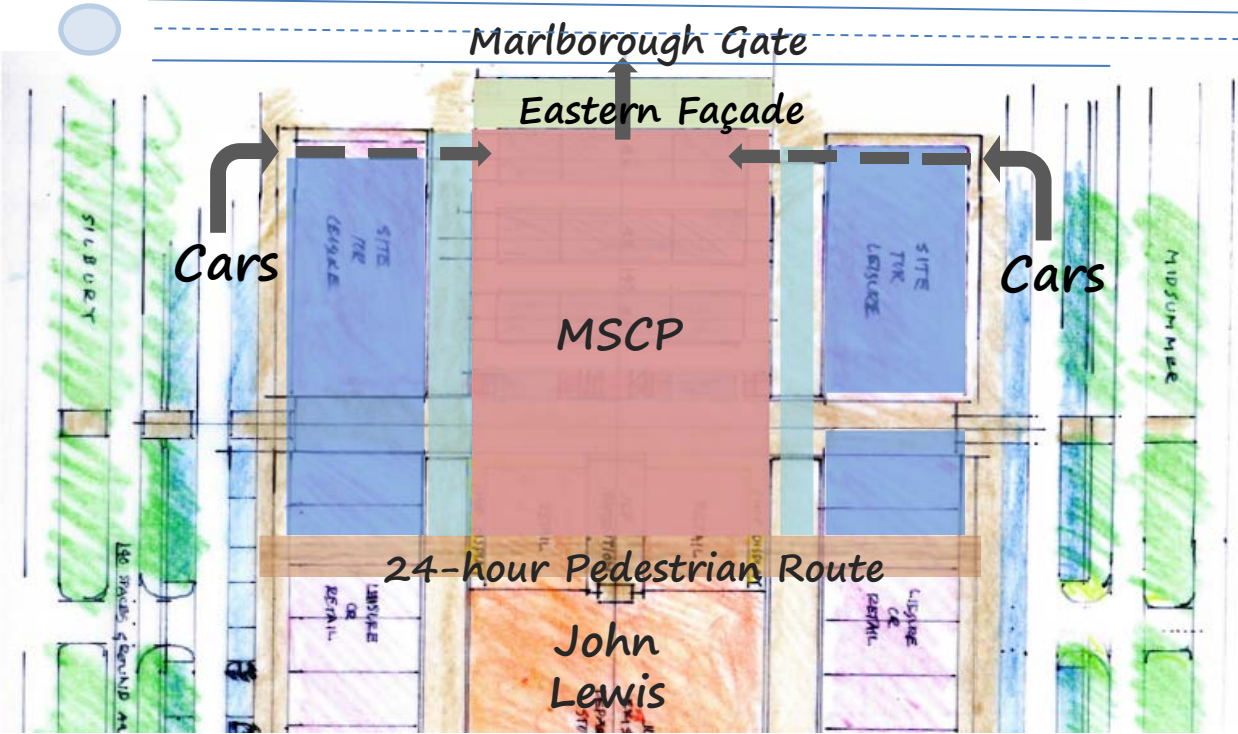


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Better access from two side entrances = fewer traffic jams, quicker bus journeys

Car parking hidden by external buildings that offer a mix of uses



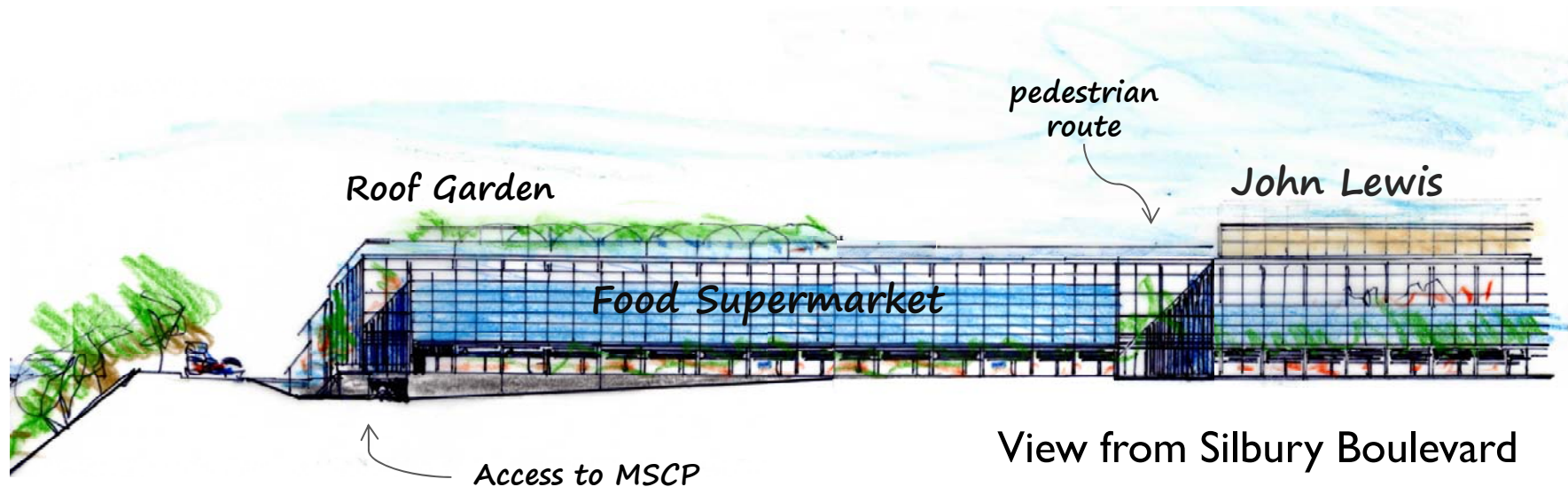

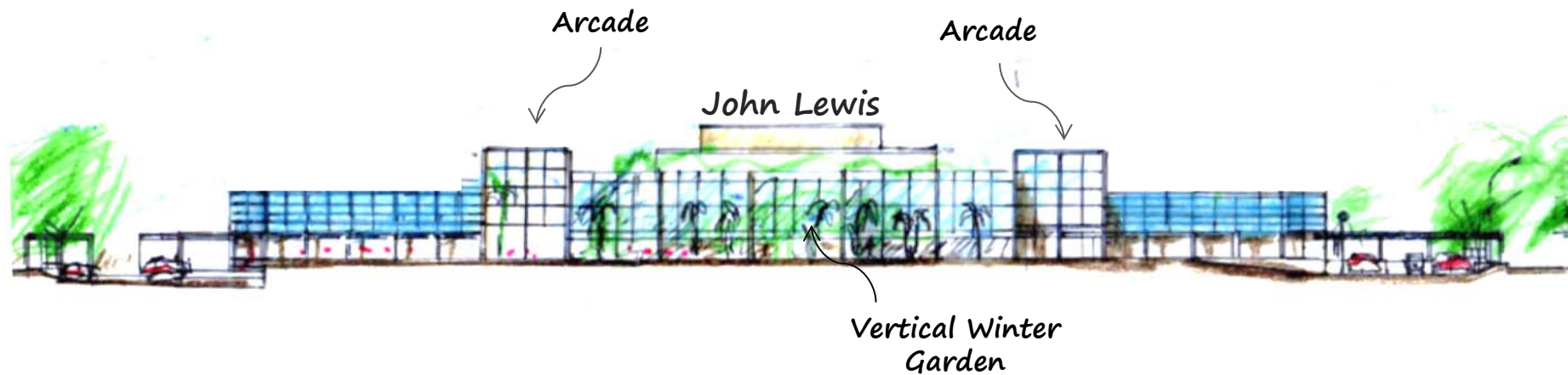

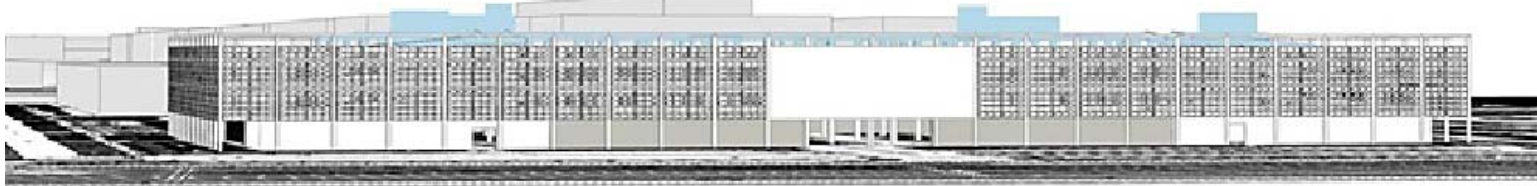
